

Admission Procedure, Rules & Regulation (LL.B. B.L.S 5 years/ LL. B 3 years): The admission for first year LL.B. B.L.S. (5years)/LL.B. (3 years) will commence to the date notified by the DHE. Seats will be allotted to the institution by the competent authority conducting CET of Maharashtra State.

Merit list of admissions will be displayed on the college notice board as per notification of DHE. Selected candidates will have to seek admission within specified date notified by DHE. The admission must be taken by the student only.

1. Eligibility for admission to LL.B. B.L.S. 5 years Integrated Course.

The candidate should be an Indian citizen.

1.1 Educational qualification: An Applicant/Candidate who has successfully completed Senior Secondary School Course ('+2') or equivalent, such as (11+1, 'A' level in Senior School Leaving Certificate Course) from a recognized University of India or Outside or from Senior Secondary Board or Equivalent, Constituted or recognized by the Union or by a state Government or from any Equivalent Institution from a Foreign Country recognized by the Government of that Country for the purpose of issue of Qualifying Certificate on successful completion of the Course/Examination, with minimum of 45% Marks in Aggregate\*. (SC and ST Category candidates belonging to the State of Maharashtra with valid Caste Certificate and Caste Validity from State of Maharashtra with minimum 40% Marks in Aggregate) Ref: (Government of Maharashtra Gazette, Extraordinary, Part-IV-B, No. 102, Dated 24<sup>th</sup> April 2017.)

1.2 Explanation: I. An applicant who has successfully completed Senior Secondary School course ('+2') or equivalent such as (11+1, 'A' level in Senior School Leaving Certificate Course) from a recognized University of India or outside or from Senior Secondary Board or equivalent, constituted or recognized by the Union or by a State Government of India or from any equivalent institution from a foreign country recognized by the Government of that country for the purpose of issue of qualifying certificate on successful completion of the course may apply for and be admitted in to the Programmed of the Centers of Legal Education to obtain the integrated degree in Law with a degree in any other subject as the first degree from the University whose such degree in law is recognized by the Bar Council of India for the purpose of enrolment.

Provided that applicant who have obtained +2 Higher Secondary pass certificate or the first-Degree Certificate after prosecuting studies in Distance or Correspondence methods shall also be considered as Eligible for admission in the Course. There should be a gap of not less than Two Years between 10th Std. (SSC) and 12th Std. (HSC) (i.e. a Candidate who has qualified SSC Examination in March 2013 should have qualified HSC Examination Not Before March 2015.) Bar Council of India Legal Education Rules-2008 and Circular No: LE: Cir.:02/2010 dated 20th December 2010. III. Provided further that the applicants who have obtained 10 Std./Secondary Schooling Certificate Examination, in a Single Sitting Examination without having any Basic Qualification (1st To 9th Standard of Schooling) is not Eligible For admission to the 5 Yrs. LL.B. Course. References: Bar Council of India Legal Education Rules-2008 and BCI Circular No: - LE: Cir.:02/2010 dated 20th December 2010 & BCI Affidavit in WP- 11378/2016. IV. The candidates who have completed 10(SSC)+2 (HSC) education following regular mode (10th, 11th, 12th) are only eligible for admission.

1.2.1 2. Eligibility for Admission to LL.B. 3 Years Degree Course.

2.1 The candidate should be an Indian National. Educational Qualifications:

2.2(a) The candidate should be a Graduate and or Post Graduate in any Faculty/ Discipline of Knowledge of any University in Maharashtra established by an act of Parliament or by the State Legislature or an equivalent National Institution recognized as a Deemed to be University or Foreign University recognized as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an Authority competent to declare equivalence, with Minimum 45% Marks in Aggregate\* for Open Category Candidates i.e. 45% Marks in Aggregate\* (for all the parts of the Degree Examination taken together), and 40% Marks in Aggregate\* in degree examination in all parts of the Degree Examination for candidates belonging to SC and ST Category belonging to State of Maharashtra only.

2.2 (b) The Candidate who has passed the 3- year Undergraduate Degree and or 2/3 Yrs. Post Graduate Degree from university mentioned above in 2.2 (a) after prosecuting the studies in the educational pattern of 10+2+3 and/or 10+2+3+2/3 Yrs. with Regular Studies at Secondary (SSC) and Higher Secondary (HSC) Schooling.

2.2 (c) Provided that, the Candidate who has obtained +2 (Higher Secondary) Certificate or First-Degree Certificate and or Post Graduation Certificate by Distance or Correspondence Method shall also be considered as Eligible for CET of LL.B. - 3 Yrs. Full Time Regular Course.

2.2 (d) Explanation: The Candidate who has passed the qualifying examination (10+2, UG and or PG) in a single sitting examination without having Basic Qualification of (10+2+3 and or +2/3) is not eligible. Further provided that, No Candidate from Open University having a Degree contrary of the UGC Act and Regulations and contrary to Rules of Legal Education shall be eligible. (Ref:1) Government Notification in Extra ordinary Gazette dated 24th April 2017.2) Government Notification in Extra ordinary Gazette dated 5th May 2017, 3) Bar Council of India-2008: Part V-5(a))

2.2 (e) The candidates who have completed 10(SSC)+2 (HSC) education following regular mode (10th, 11th, 12th) are only eligible for admission.

1. Statement of Marks (3 Photocopies Attested) of Std. X, XI & XII passed in single sitting for LL.B./B.L.S. (5 years)
2. Statement of Marks (3 Photocopies Attested) of Std. X, XI, XII and Degree mark sheets passed in single sitting for LL.B. (3 years)
3. Passing Certificate indicating date of birth (2 Photocopies Attested) of Std. XII
4. Leaving Certificate/Birth Certificate (2Photocopies Attested) from school/ college
5. Provisional Eligibility Certificate from Mumbai University if the student migrates from the Board other than Maharashtra Board
6. Passport and Visa, in case of overseas/ foreign students. Tourist Visa / Entry Visa willnot be considered
7. Four recent passport size photographs
8. CET application
9. Hall Ticket
